- Open at 8:00 AM, completion by 10:30 AM.
- Tear down at 3:00 PM
- Provide your tent, table, chairs, signage, and power requirements
- Participants are responsible for their own electricity needs.

5. Market Arrival & Departure

- Vendors should be ready by 10:30 AM.
- Consult the organizers if arriving later than 60 minutes before opening.
- Vehicle movement within the market is restricted until 1:15 PM.

6. General Rules

- No hawking or disruptive behaviour.
- Drive cautiously within the market area.
- Comply with The Weights and Measures Act for sales by weight.
- No sales of promotional items meant to advertise the vendor's own business.

7. Code of Conduct

- Respect and courtesy are always expected.
- No abusive language or altering of other vendor's spaces.
